Issac Naylor, 1824-1885, was born in Ohio, a descendent of an English Quaker family which settled in Philadelphia at the time of William Penn. Issac came to Galveston in 1851 where he conducted a school until 1856. He later lived in Dallas, became an attorney, and, in 1858, married Henrietta Wood, daughter of E. S. Wood who operated a large hardware business on the Strand in Galveston. Issac worked as a bookkeeper in this firm during his later years in Galveston.

Papers include manuscript and published genealogies of the Naylor and related families, and correspondence on family history from relatives.
