Family personal and business letters. The general correspondence (personal & business) mainly includes letter with friends in New Madrid, Mo. Most family members lived in Haverhill, W. H. and other parts of the northeast. One brother, Henry, went to the California gold fields. A letter from him (to another brother, James) is included. One sister, Mary, married Edward H. Cushing and lived in Houston. Barstow originally settled in Valasco. After his marriage to Charlotte Labadie, he apparently lived in the Columbia area, engaging in the general retail trade.
