Principally papers of Samuel Wythe Barnes and his wife, Isabel Moses Barnes. Born in Norwich, England, April 4, 1852, Samuel Wythe Barnes came to Galveston during the early 1880s, working as a bookkeeper and cashier. He served as deputy clerk of Galveston County around 1886-1887. In March 1905, he was appointed British vice-consul at Galveston. He also served as secretary of Trinity Episcopal Church in Galveston, 1894-1897, and helped found Holy Trinity Church at Dickinson. Barnes died in Dickinson, September 2, 1931.
