Alfreda Houston currently serves as the Executive Director of St. Vincent's Episcopal House, which offers programs such as pre-school, immunization, child care, Cub Scouts, and other recreation activities to underprivileged families. She was the recipient of the Rabbi Henry Cohen Humanitarian Award in 1989 and was the first recipient of the Steel Oleander Award in 1994.

She has also served as a chairman of the Galveston Parks & Recreation Commission, and on the Galveston Hospice Board of Directors, Family Planning Advisory Board of Directors, BPA Housing Development Corporation, GISD Tri-Ethnic Committee, and the PRIDE committee at Ball High School.

These papers are an expanding collection. The personal correspondence contains mainly congratulations and thank you cards surrounding her Steel Oleander Award. The bulk of the collection is printed matter from groups or organizations that Mrs. Houston has been involved with.
